

CONCEPT NOTE

INDIAN NATIONAL MOVEMENT WAS NOT A HOMOGENOUS MOVEMENT. VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE SOCIETY PARTICIPATED IN IT. IN THIS WEBINAR WE SHALL TRY TO UNRAVEL HOW VARIOUS STRATUM OF THE SOCIETY AND VARIOUS SOCIAL GROUPS TRIED TO CONTRIBUTE TO INDIAN NATIONAL MOVEMENT AND HOW THEIR CLASS INTERESTS SHAPED THEIR ANTI-COLONIAL STRUGGLE. THE AIM OF THIS WEBINAR IS TO APPRECIATE AND DISCUSS THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF MULTIPLE SOCIAL GROUPS TO ANTI-COLONIAL MOVEMENT IN BRITISH-INDIA AND TO UNDERSTAND THE FORMATION OF AN INDEPENDENT NATION WHICH WAS CERTAINLY NOT A MONOLITHIC PROCESS.

PROF. JAYATI NAG WILL TRY TO ELABORATE HOW WORKING CLASS GROUPS PARTICIPATED IN ANTI COLONIAL STRUGGLE. SHE WILL MAINLY FOCUS ON THE CASE STUDY OF CONTRIBUTION OF RAIL WORKERS OF BENGAL TO INDIAN NATIONAL MOVEMENT.

DR. PAROMITA DAS GUPTA WILL PRESENT SOME SELECT CASE STUDIES TO DIVULGE THE BURNING ISSUES AT COLONIAL WORKPLACES AND PUT THE PERTINENT QUESTIONS IN PERSPECTIVE: 1) HOW DID THE SOCIO-CULTURAL CATEGORIES OF "RACE AND CLASS" SHAPE THE DIFFERENTIATED ACCESS TO "OPPORTUNITIES AND CHALLENGES" IN THE SALARIED LIFE-WORLD 2) TO WHAT EXTENT DID COLONIAL EMPLOYMENT PATTERNS AND TECHNO-CRATIC TOOLS PLAY A DECISIVE ROLE IN REINFORCING THE "CLASS CONSCIOUSNESS" OR EVEN POLITICAL ASPIRATIONS AMONG 'NATIVE' EMPLOYEES? 3) HOW DID THE HAZARDS OF "CHAKRI" OR 'PETTY CLERICAL WORK' AFFECT EVERYDAY DOMESTIC LIFE AND INFLUENCE PERSONAL CHOICES OF THE GROUPS AFFECTED? DR DASGUPTA WILL INTEND TO DISCUSS BRIEFLY THE RACE- AND CLASS-INFLECTED POWER RELATIONS AND OPPORTUNITIES IN SALARIED LIFE THAT HAD AN IMPORTANT IMPACT ON THE WORK AND DOMESTIC LIFE OF THE COLONIAL MIDDLE-CLASS AS WELL AS IN SHAPING THEIR SPECIFIC CLASS IDENTITY AND APPROACH TOWARDS THE COLONIAL RULERS.

PROF. AMRITA SETT WILL FOCUS ON THE CONTRIBUTION OF WOMEN TO INDIAN NATIONAL MOVEMENT AND HOW IT SHAPED WOMENS' IDENTITY IN INDIA.

DR. SANDIP CHATTERJEE WILL DISCUSS THE COLONIAL STEREOTYPES PERTAINING TO 'KNOWLEDGE' AND 'IGNORANCE' IN THE EASTERN INDIAN COLLIERIES AFFECTING INDIAN COAL MINERS AND INDIAN MINE ENGINEERS. DR. CHATTERJEE WILL DEMONSTRATE HOW THOSE STEREOTYPES POSED SERIOUS HINDRANCES TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF NATIONAL IDENTITY.

- 1) Nineteenth-century Bengali middleclass
- 2) Lord Thomas Babington Macaulay (1835 Minute) – Vernacular Education or English education → key to full colonization & political control
- 3) Anglicist ইংরেজিবিদ – Orientalist প্রাচ্যবিদ Debate – Upward mobility (উর্ধ্বগামী গতিশীলতা) → pecuniary/ financial gains
- 4) 1857 - Establishment of 3 universities – Bombay, Calcutta, Madras
→ a class of graduates emerged – Bankim Chandra Chattyopadhyay and Jadunath Bose

'Ignorant' miners and occupational hazards: changes in the typologies of accidents

- The propensity to put the blame on miners was given a concrete shape in **1912**
- new CATEGORIES of accidents were introduced in the annual report of the Chief Inspector of Mines
- The typology of accidents was changed to accidents due to '**MISADVENTURE,**' due to the '**FAULT OF THE DECEASED**' and due to the '**FAULT OF THE FELLOW WORKMEN,**'
- A few accidents were ascribed to the **FAULT OF THE MANAGEMENT** and **FAULT OF THE SUBORDINATE OFFICIALS**

How the European Engineers Faired

- The students of the ISM claimed: "For similar and even lower qualification possessed by Europeans and for the same post, needless to say they are paid high, **starting not less than three to four hundred Rupees** in the very first instance."
- European engineers appointed as managers could receive salaries **as high as 550-650 Rupees**.
- In a nutshell, the industry's **dependence on foreign personnel continued** while attempts to promote Indian candidates were conspicuously missing.

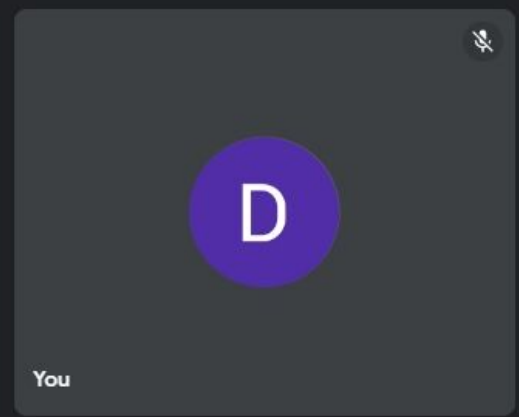

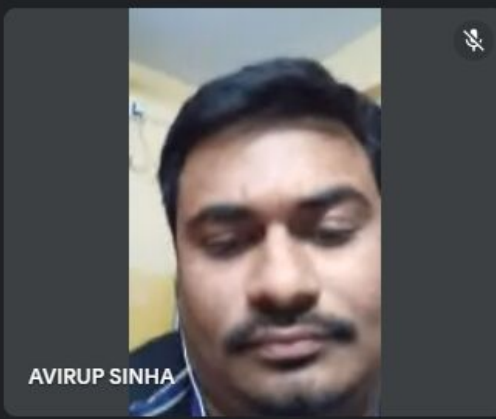
